## The school will:

- 1. Care for the safety and welfare of all children.
- 2. Aim for all children to achieve their potential in all parts of school life.

- 2. Listen and follow all adults' instructions.
- 3. Focus positively on their learning.
- 4. Respect others and their property.
- 5. Take care of the School.
- 6. Always do their best to keep the school values and rules.
- 7. Read at home regularly.
- 8. Complete their Home Learning.

## Parents will:

- 1. Aim for 100% attendance for their child.
- 2. Ensure their child arrives at school for 8.45 am.
- 3. Collect their child on time.
- 4. Do regular reading activities with their child, eg read to them, listen to them read, talk about books, provide a range of reading sources for their child: books; magazines, comics or e-reading.
- 5. Support their child with their Home Assisted Learning.
- 6. Support the School's policies and approach on:
  - a) Behaviour.
  - b) School uniform and appearance.
  - c) The use of social media (see separate guidance).
- 7. Regularly attend Parents' Evening and events to support their child's education.
- 8. Inform the School of any concerns or problems that might affect their child at school.
- 9. Respect others and not use aggressive or abusive behaviour on the school site or on the phone.
- 10. Help keep the School a safe and suitable place for young children and their families.
